Directions to Oakley Community Center:

From North: I-71 to Ridge Ave/Kennedy Ave., Exit 8; Turn left at the end of ramp; at next light turn onto Ridge Ave.; stay on Ridge for 1.3 miles (Ridge becomes 'Marburg' at Madison Rd). Turn right on Paxton Ave; go past Kinko's (left); turn left into Hyde Park Plaza. Center is located in the far left corner of the plaza, to the left of Biggs.

From Downtown: I-71 North to Smith-Edwards, exit 6; at the end of the ramp, turn right onto Edmondson then right onto Edwards Rd. After crossing Madison Rd., turn left onto Wasson Rd.; stay on Wasson for about .5 mile; railroad tracks are on right. At traffic light, stay to left, onto Paxton; Turn right at the 2nd light. The Center is located in the far left corner of the plaza, to the left of Biggs.
